

Make your plans now for The Stratford Festival 2019

This year we are going during the Fall 2019 mid-semester break

Total cost of trip per student = \$200

Cost includes tickets to 3 performances, transportation by OWU vans, 2 nights lodging

All meals are at your own expense.

***March 18 through March 22, 2019:** \$50 (non-refundable) deposit - For Theatre/Dance majors & minors only at this time - this will reserve your tickets for the Stratford Festival. This gives you major and minor students first chance at getting a ticket reserved and making sure you get to go.

***March 25, 2019:** \$50 (non-refundable) deposit - Open to all OWU students at this time, to reserve tickets for the Stratford Festival

***April 22, 2019:** \$75 due

***August 21, 2019:** \$75 due (first day of classes)

OTHER THINGS TO NOTE:

- This year we will be staying in a motel. To keep the price affordable, we have reserved some rooms with 2 queen beds, so it will be 4 students per room and some rooms have 1 double bed, so it will be 2 students per room.
- You need a valid, **current US passport**. If you carry another passport, you will need to have the necessary visa arrangements well ahead of time.
- You will need about \$60 extra in cash for food (more, if you intend to purchase souvenirs).
- The trip takes about eight hours (including a stop for lunch). Transportation will be in OWU vans. You will return to campus about 6pm Saturday night.
- We will need several certified drivers, besides the chaperones. If you are already certified, please let me know. If you would like to help drive, you can easily become certified through Public Safety - please let me know and I can help you with certification.
- FYI - if our tickets are in the balcony, seating is not handicap accessible for people needing a wheelchair or walker or who find stair climbing challenging. We will not know our exact seating until the tickets are assigned to us at a later date.
