Sanjay Rishi is a filmmaker and a business-leadership coach who has created provocative learning interventions for global audiences for the last three decades. He facilitates transformation for leaders and their organizations in sectors such as the UN, social business, entrepreneurial start-ups, for-profit, and education.
